Ineligible / Immigration / Commercial testing
(Effective 1 July 2021 to 30 June 2022)

Test Funding Eligibility

Not all patients are eligible for government funded laboratory testing. This publication outlines when patients must be charged, the payment amount to be collected and the payment options available.

NB: Having an NHI does not indicate eligibility

When should a Patient be charged?

Payment is **always** required from New Zealand (including those from the Cook Islands, Niue or Tokelau) and Non-New Zealand citizens when they:

- are applying for a visa or immigration permit
- require an insurance health check e.g. hepatitis status, HIV status, lipids
- are getting a pre-employment check e.g. MRSA, Mantoux, infectious diseases
- are getting non-diagnostic testing done e.g.
 - checking immune status related to vaccination or travel, sporting club clearances
 - student enrolment requirements
 - blood grouping unrelated to transfusion
 - anti-aging clinics, slimming programs
- require employment related checks e.g.: lead or mercury levels, drug testing, pilot medicals
- have been referred by a dentist or an alternative health provider
- are self - requesting tests

Non-New Zealand citizens are charged for all tests unless:

- they are a resident of the United Kingdom or Australia having **urgent** care (reciprocal arrangements exist)
- they have a current work permit valid at least 2 years, or renewed work permits (including student visa) totalling at least 2 years. Time spent lawfully in New Zealand immediately prior to the current work visa/permit counts towards the two years (i.e. on a visitor or student visa/permit or another work visa/permit).
- are a person who requires services relating to infectious or quarantinable diseases (includes diagnosis, follow-up and contact testing)
- they have refugee status, or are in the process of applying for refugee status
- they are having maternity care (includes pre and post-natal) and their partner is eligible
- the testing relates to an accident, in which case it is covered by the ACC
- they are a student funded under NZAID, an ODA scholar or a Commonwealth Scholarship holder
- they are the spouse, or dependent child aged 19, or under care of an ODA scholar Need more information? Go to www.moh.govt.nz/eligibility
