PATIENT INSTRUCTIONS

Important - Specimen labelling and delivery:

- 1. Ensure full first and last names and date of birth (dd/mm/yy) are clearly written on the 24 hour urine container label.
- 2. Ensure date and time of collection is written on the request form and 24 hour urine container label.
- 3. Take the specimen to a Northland Pathology Collection Centre as soon after collection as possible.

24 Hour urine containers:

You have been provided with a 24 hour urine container and urine punnets to collect a 24 hour urine sample.

Procedure:

- 1. Start the urine collect early in the morning and record the date and time on the 24 hour urine container label
- 2. Completely empty bladder at this time and DISCARD the urine.
- During the next 24 hours, collect ALL urine passed into the clean urine punnet and transfer into the 24 hour urine container.
- 4. Exactly 24 hours after the start time, empty your bladder, collect the urine and transfer to the 24 hour urine container.
- 5. Record the completion date and time on the 24 hour urine container label.
- 6. If more than one 24 hour urine container is used, label the bottles 1 and 2.
- 7. Store the 24 hour urine collect in a cool place.
