Seminal Fluid (Sperm) Collection Post Vasectomy

About your Test

- Your health professional has requested a test to count the number of sperm present in your seminal fluid following a vasectomy.
- You will need to obtain a specimen container and specimen delivery bag from your health professional or from one of our collection centres.
- Please produce your sample at home. Our collection centre rooms are unsuitable for this purpose.

Test Procedure

- Collect your sample by masturbation without the use of a lubricant do not use a condom to collect your sample as the spermicidal agent in the condom will affect your test results.
- 2. Ensure you collect all the seminal fluid produced into the specimen container and screw the lid down firmly.
- 3. Label the specimen container with your full name, your date of birth, and the date and time of the collection.
- 4. Place the specimen container in the delivery bag provided, with the form in the front pocket.

Please deliver your sample to Medlab (Queen Street Timaru Hospital).
